THIS DAY this cause came on for hearing upon the petition of Florida Exploration Company asking that the Special Field Rules for the Amanda Chapel Field (Black Creek Field) be adopted by this Board and the Board, being fully advised, does find as follows:

1.

Proper, due and legal notice for the meeting of this Board to consider this application has been given as required by law and the rules of this Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication of notice are on file with this Board. The Board does further adjudicate that it has full and complete jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine this petition at this time and place.

2.

Florida Exploration Company has drilled its International Paper Company Unit 5-6 Well No. 1 under Permit No. 453 dated January 10, 1980, on a 640 acre unit consisting of Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 10 West, Stone County, Mississippi, and has encountered a gas pool in the Hosston formation which it proposed to define as the Hosston - Josephine Gas Pool. Said well was a wildcat well. The petition filed in this docket was to adopt Special Field Rules for this area which Florida Exploration Company proposed to call the Amanda Chapel Field, subject to approval of this Board and to define said Hosston - Josephine Gas Pool.

3.

It appears that this area is commonly known as the Black Creek Area and the field should be called the Black Creek Field rather than the Amanda Chapel Field.

4.

Florida Exploration Company has recommended to the Board that the following Field Rules be adopted for the Black Creek Field:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR
BLACK CREEK FIELD,
STONE AND PERRY COUNTIES, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Black Creek Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land as underlain by the Hosston - Josephine Gas Pool and all productive extensions thereof:

Perry County, Mississippi

Township 1 South, Range 10 West

Sections 31, 32, 33, 34 and 35

Stone County, Mississippi

Township 2 South, Range 10 West

Sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6

B. The Hosston - Josephine Gas Pool of the Black Creek Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 14,044 feet to 14,172 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction-Laterolog of the Florida Exploration Company - International Paper Company Unit 5-6 No. 1 Well, located 2,127 feet from the North line and 1,906 feet from the West line of Section 5, Township 2 South, Range 10 West, Stone County, Mississippi, and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

Rule 1 - Applicability of Statewide Rules

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order 201-51 and all effective amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules, are hereby adopted and shall apply to this field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Special Field Rules of Black Creek Field to define the Hosston - Josephine Gas Pool be adopted as hereinabove set forth.
