ORDER REPEALING RULE 2 OF THE SPECIAL FIELD
RULES FOR CARTHAGE POINT FIELD IN ADAMS COUNTY,
MISSISSIPPI

This day the application of The Pure Oil Company, an Ohio corporation, for the repeal of Rule 2 of the Special Field Rules of the Carthage Point Field in Adams County, Mississippi, came on for hearing before the Mississippi State Oil and Gas Board, and the Board finding that due, legal and sufficient notice of this meeting and hearing of this Docket has been given within the manner, time and form prescribed by the rules and regulations of this Board, and the Board further finding that due, legal and sufficient proofs of the publication of said notice are on file with the Board and that the State Oil and Gas Board has full jurisdiction to hear and try this cause for the purpose of considering the repeal of the aforesaid Rule 2 of the Special Field Rules of the Carthage Point Field in Adams County, Mississippi, and the Board having received all the evidence offered and being of the opinion that there is no longer any necessity for the taking of bottom hole pressure tests provided to be taken by said Rule 2, the Board hereby repeals said Rule 2 of the Special Field Rules for the Carthage Point Field in Adams County, Mississippi.

The Rule hereby repealed being as follows:

"Bottom hole pressure tests shall be made during the month of December of each calendar year of wells completed in and producing from the Lower Tuscaloosa Gas Pool. Such tests shall be made to the extent and in the manner provided by the Board. The expense of each of said tests shall be borne by the Operator of each of the wells so tested."
