ORDER

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the petition of D. J. Simmons, of Fort Worth, Texas, for the adoption and promulgation by the Board of Special Field Rules for the Coleville Field, Chickasaw County, Mississippi; and

The Board, finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

Pursuant to said notice given, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on December 21, 1966, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed Special Field Rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those persons at said meeting; and

The Board having fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing, is of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the following Special Field Rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board for the Coleville Field, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after December 21, 1966.

SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE COLEVILLE FIELD
CHICKASAW COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The Coleville Field, as used herein, is that area in Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, Township 12 South, Range 4 East, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, underlain by the Mississippian Gas Pool, including all productive extensions thereof.

A. The Coleville Field Mississippian Gas Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of gas and gas condensate as encountered in the Vaughey & Vaughey - USA No. 1 Well located 450 feet West of the East line and 410 feet North of the South line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 12 South, Range 4 East, Chickasaw County, Mississippi.

B. To enable development of the pool, to prevent waste, and otherwise carry out the provisions of law, it is necessary that the following Special Field Rules and regulations be adopted for the Coleville Field for production from the Mississippian Gas Pool:

RULE 1 - SPACING OF GAS WELLS

Every well drilled as a gas well for production from the Mississippian Gas Pool:

- (a) shall be located at least 1320 feet from every other drilling or producible well located in the Coleville Field completed in or producing from the same gas pool;
- (b) shall be located at least 660 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

- (a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically

covered by the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field; and

- (b) The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
