## IN THE STATE OIL AND GAS BOARD OF MISSISSIPPI

RE: PETITION OF BROWNING & WELCH, INC.  
TO AMEND THE SPECIAL FIELD RULES OF  
COOPER CREEK FIELD, LOWNDES COUNTY,  
MISSISSIPPI.

ORDER NO. 423.84O R D E R

THIS DAY this matter came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of Browning & Welch, Inc., to amend the Special Field Rules of Cooper Creek Field, Lowndes County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board; that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board; and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, public hearing was held by said Board in the 14th floor hearing room of the Walter Sillers State Office Building, 550 High Street, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on September 19, 1984, at which hearing all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and finds as follows:

1. Petitioner has drilled and successfully completed its Elbert Wheat 2-6 No. 1 Well at a location in Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 17 West and completed said well as a gas well in the Nason Sand at a depth of less than 2,500 feet. The Nason Sand as encountered by this well is a separate accumulation of gas from the previously defined pools in this field and should therefore be separately defined as the Nason Sand Gas Pool of Cooper Creek Field.

2. As a further result of this discovery, Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 17 West should be added to the sections previously included and defined as Cooper Creek Field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules for Cooper Creek Field be and are hereby amended to read as follows:

AMENDED SPECIAL FIELD RULES  
FOR COOPER CREEK FIELD,  
LOWNDES COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Cooper Creek Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land as underlain by the Nason Sand Gas Pool, Lewis Sand Gas Pool and the Carter "B" Sand Gas Pool, and all productive extensions thereof:

Lowndes County, Mississippi

Sections 27, 28, 33, 34, and 35 of Township 16 South, Range 17 West, and Sections 1, 2 and 3 of Township 17 South, Range 17 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi.

B. The Carter "B" Sand Gas Pool of the Cooper Creek Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 4,638 and 4,675 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction SFL Log for the Placid Oil Company - Vaughan No. 1 Well, located in Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 17 West, Lowndes County, Mississippi, and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

C. The Lewis Sand Gas Pool of the Cooper Creek Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in

the interval between the depth of 5,303 and 5,340 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction SFL Log for the Placid Oil Company - Caldwell 28-10 Well No. 1 located in Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 17 West, and all correlative intervals in communications therewith.

D. The Nason Sand Gas Pool of Cooper Creek Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 2,290 feet and 2,433 feet as indicated on the electric log of the Browning & Welch, Inc. - Elbert Wheat 2-6 No. 1 Well located in Section 2, Township 17 South, Range 17 West and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

Rule 1 - Applicability of Statewide Rules

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order 201-51 and all effective amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules, are hereby adopted and shall apply to this field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend, or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules.
