O R D E R

THIS DAY this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of Southeastern Resources, Inc. for Special Field Rules permitting directional drilling and defining the oil pools in the Southeast Corner Lake Field, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purposes; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, North West Street, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on April 16, 1975, at which hearing all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations and finds that said Special Field Rules should be amended to now provide as follows:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE SOUTHEAST CORNER LAKE FIELD,
WILKINSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Southeast Corner Lake Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land, to wit:

Sections 7 and 10, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, underlain by the oil pools hereinafter described and all productive extensions thereof.

B. (1) The McKittrick Sand Pool shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil in the interval between 7603 feet and 7689 feet in the Southeastern Resources, Inc.-Magee No. 1 Well located in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, as indicated on the electric log of said well and all intervals correlative of said strata productive of hydrocarbons.

(2) The Tew Lake Sand Pool shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil in the interval from 7371 feet to 7398 feet in the Southeastern Resources, Inc.-Magee-Ventress Unit No. 1 Well located on the NW Corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, as indicated on the electric log of said well and all intervals correlative of said strata productive of hydrocarbons.

(3) The Armstrong Sand Pool shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil in the interval between 7734 feet to 7794 feet in the Southeastern Resources, Inc.-Magee-Ventress Unit No. 1 Well located on the NW Corner of the SE 1/4 of Section 7, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, Wilkinson

County, Mississippi, as indicated on the electric log of said well and all intervals correlative of said strata productive of hydrocarbons.

C. The characteristics of the above-described pools are such that wells located in conformance with the Statewide Spacing Rules as herein modified will efficiently drain and produce all the recoverable hydrocarbons from said pools.

RULE 1 - DIRECTIONAL DRILLING PERMITTED

(a) Deviated or directionally drilled wells may be permitted by the Supervisor of the State Oil and Gas Board without notice and hearing when the surface location of any such well is affected by the waters of Lake Mary.

(b) The Supervisor shall issue permits approving the directional drilling of wells from surface locations which are not in conformance with the Spacing Rules when the proposed bottomhole location for any such well is located within, and at least 330 feet from the boundary of, the unit for said well.

(c) The application for permit for a directionally drilled well shall be accompanied by a plat showing the surface location, the bottomhole location and the drilling unit assigned to the well.

(d) A directional survey shall be conducted on each deviated well prior to setting of production casing and a certified copy thereof filed with the State Oil and Gas Board within 30 days.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

(a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field


Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

(b) The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
