ORDER NO. 209-55

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board of special field rules for the Darrington Field in Wilkinson County, Mississippi, said hearing being called for such purpose by said Board; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication ^{are on file} are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS pursuant to said notice given a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building at Jackson, Mississippi on October 19, 1955, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed special field rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the opinion that the following special field rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board that the following special field rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the Darrington Field located in Wilkinson County, Mississippi, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR DARRINGTON FIELD
IN WILKINSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Darrington Field, as used herein, is that area in the $S\frac{1}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31, Township 4 North, Range 2 West; and the $N\frac{1}{2}$ and the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 2 West; and the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, Township 4 North, Range 1 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by the Harmon B pool as hereinafter defined.

B. The Harmon B pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from the depths of 7091 feet to 7107 feet in the Crosby Lumber and Manufacturing Company - Crosby-Young No. 2 Well located 500 feet from the West and South lines in the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

RULE 1

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51 and amendments thereto are hereby adopted and

shall apply to said field.

The Board expressly reserves its right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
