ORDER ADOPTING SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE EAST FAIRVIEW FIELD, ADAMS
COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

This cause having come on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi on this day pursuant to an order duly adopted by said Board directing that a public hearing be held to hear and consider proposals for and adopt special field rules for the East Fairview Field, Adams County, Mississippi on this date and pursuant to the publication of a notice of said hearing, given in the manner and for the length of time as required by law and the rules and regulations of said Board, proofs of publication of said notice so given being now on file in this proceeding; and

Public hearing having been had on this day by said Board at the time and place specified in said notice of hearing on said matter, and the Board having heard all interested persons appearing and presenting evidence or recommendations in connection with said cause and the Board being fully advised as to said evidence and recommendations and having fully considered same, being of the opinion and so finding that the following should be adopted as the special field rules for the East Fairview Field in Adams County, Mississippi and that same should be accordingly promulgated by said Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is accordingly hereby ordered that the following be and the same are hereby adopted as the special field rules for said East Fairview Field in Adams County, Mississippi, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR EAST
FAIRVIEW FIELD, ADAMS COUNTY,
MISSISSIPPI

- A. The East Fairview Field as used herein is that area in Sections 6, 9 and 10 of Township 4 North, Range 4 West, in Adams County, Mississippi, and including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by any one or more of the following pools, to-wit:
- a. The Norman 1 Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,320 feet to 6,342 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-9 well, located 660 feet north of the south line, and 1,980 feet east of the west line of Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
 - B. The Norman 2 Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,392 feet to 6,407 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-11 Well, located 1,000 feet east of the west line and 330 feet north of the south line of Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County Mississippi, and those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
 - c. The Norman 3 Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,412 feet to 6,424 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-7 Well, from the northwest corner of Section 9 go easterly 869 feet along the north line of Section 9, thence southerly 330 feet at right angles to the location in Section 9, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
 - d. The Armstrong Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,710 feet to 6,746 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-1 Well, located 1,500 feet south of the north line and 800 feet east of west line of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
 - e. The Baker Oil Pool, as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,771 feet to 6,788 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-3 Well, located from the northeast corner of Section 10, go 1,186 feet southerly along the east line of the section, thence 136 feet westerly at right angles to the location in Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

- f. The Parker Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,816 feet to 6,825 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-8 Well, located 1,000 feet north of the south line and 660 feet east of the west line of Section 6, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.
- g. The Ball Oil Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox group productive of oil from a depth of 6,874 feet to 6,884 feet in the Humble Oil & Refining Company's N. H. Breaux D-6 Well, located 1,700 feet south of the north line, and 700 feet east of the west line of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 4 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

RULE 1

No. well shall be drilled ~~less than~~ ^{within} 100 feet from any other producing well regardless of the pool from which it is producing.

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and amendments thereto not specifically covered in the foregoing rules, are hereby adopted and shall apply to said Field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the above rules and regulations.
