ORDER NO. 253-73

ORDER

This day this cause coming on to be heard on the Amended Petition of Cities Service Oil Company, qualified to do and doing business in the State of Mississippi, on the matter of adoption and promulgation by the State Oil and Gas Board of Special Field Rules for the Glancy Field in Copiah County, Mississippi; and

The Board finding and hereby adjudicating that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board, and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same.

The Board having fully considered the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board of Special Field Rules for the Glancy Field in Copiah County, Mississippi, and the evidence and recommendations made with reference to said matter, is of the opinion that the attached Temporary Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in the field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the following Temporary Special Field Rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board for the Glancy Field, Copiah County, Mississippi, subject to an Order of this Board to be entered at the regular October, 1975 meeting of this Board, upon notice to be given for a hearing at such meeting, to review and redetermine appropriate spacing rules.

SPECIAL FIELD RULES
FOR THE GLANCY FIELD
COPIAH COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

The Glancy Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land, to-wit:

Sections 7, 8, 9, 16, 17 and 18, Township 9
North, Range 7 East, and Sections 12 and 13,
Township 9 North, Range 6 East, Copiah County,
Mississippi,

underlain by the Lower Cotton Valley Gas Pool, and all productive extensions thereof.

I. The Lower Cotton Valley Gas Pool in the Glancy Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Cotton Valley Formation productive of gas in the interval between the electric log depths of 19,490 feet to 20,721 feet in the Cities Service Oil Company - No. A-1 Sanders Well, as indicated on the electric log of said well, and all sands correlative of these strata productive of gas, said well being located 1090 feet from the North line and 500 feet from the East line of Section 8, Township 9 North, Range 7 East, Copiah County, Mississippi.

II. The characteristics of the Lower Cotton Valley Gas Pool in said field are such that a well located as hereinafter prescribed and drilled upon a drilling unit consisting of two governmental sections containing not less than 1200 acres or more than 1360 acres upon which no other drilling or producible well is located will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable gas from such units in said pool without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - SPACING OF GAS WELLS:

With respect to the Lower Cotton Valley Gas Pool, every well drilled as a gas well:

(a) shall be located upon a drilling unit consisting of two governmental sections containing not less than 1200 acres or

more than 1360 acres upon which no other drilling or producible well is located;

(b) shall be located not less than 1500 feet from every exterior boundary of the unit;

(c) shall be located at least 3000 feet from every other drilling or producible well located in conformity with this rule.

RULE 2 - DIRECTIONAL SURVEYS

Directional surveys will be made from the surface to intermediate casing depth and an additional survey from the casing depth to total depth or as deep as mechanically practical.

Surveys may either be gyroscopic or magnetic type but will not be calculated from a dipmeter.

RULE 3 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:

A. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

B. The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.

C. The above and foregoing rules and regulations shall be in force and effect for a two-year period from date of adoption thereof.
