ORDER NO. 126-68

O R D E R

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of JOE G. STRAHAN for the adoption by the Board of Special Field Rules for the Jackson Gas Field, Rankin County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter has been given in the manner and way provided by law and the Rules and Regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on May 15, 1968, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all proposed Special Field Rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in

said hearing and is of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

It is therefore ordered and adjudged that Special Field Rules for the Jackson Gas Field be hereby adopted:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR JACKSON GAS FIELD, RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

- A. The Jackson Gas Field, as used herein, is that area in the Northeast quarter of Section 1, Township 5 North, Range 1 East, and in the Southeast quarter of Section 36, Township 6 North, Range 1 East, Rankin County, Mississippi, and all productive extensions thereof, underlain by the hereinafter defined pools.
- B. (1) The Wilcox "No. 1" Sand Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of gas from the Sonic-Neutron log depths of 1172 feet to 1183 feet in the Joe G. Strahan Love Petroleum Corp. No. 1 Well located in Section 1, T 5 N, R 1 W, Rankin County, Mississippi, and those strata which may be correlated therewith.
- (2) The Wilcox "No. 2" Sand Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of gas from the Sonic-Neutron log depths of 1110 feet to 1116 feet in the Joe G. Strahan, Love Petroleum Corp. No. 2 Well located in Section 36, T 6 N, R 1 E, Rankin County, Mississippi, and those strata which may be correlated therewith.
- C. The characteristics of the Wilcox "No. 1" Sand Pool and the Wilcox "No. 2" Sand Pool are such that wells drilled in conformity to the spacing rules provided in the Statewide Rules and Regulations will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable ~~oil~~ <sup>gas</sup> in said pools without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

- A. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.
- B. The Board expressly reserves the right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
