O R D E R

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of UNION PRODUCING COMPANY for the adoption by the Board of Special Field Rules for the South Jeanette Field, Adams County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter has been given in the manner and way provided by law and the Rules and Regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on May 15, 1968, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all proposed Special Field Rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said

matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

It is therefore ordered and adjudged that Special Field Rules for South Jeanette Field be hereby adopted:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR SOUTH JEANETTE FIELD, ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

- A. The South Jeanette Field, as used herein, is that area in Sections 33, 41 and 42, Township 6 North, Range 1 West, Adams County, Mississippi underlain by the hereinafter defined pools, and all productive extensions thereof.
- B. (1) The Benbrook Sand Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the subsea depths of 5974 feet to 5988 feet in the Union Producing Company - Webster-Shortridge and Williams, Baker Unit No. 2 Well located in Section 42, T 6 N, R 1 W, Adams County, Mississippi, and those strata which may be correlated therewith.

(2) The 4600-Foot Sand Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the subsea depths of 4367 feet to 4433 feet in the Union Producing Company - Webster-Shortridge and Williams, Baker Unit No. 2 Well located in Section 42, T 6 N, R 1 W, Adams County, Mississippi, and those strata which may be correlated therewith.
- C. The characteristics of the Benbrook Sand Pool and the 4600-Foot Sand Pool are such that wells drilled in conformity to the spacing rules provided in the Statewide Rules and Regulations

will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable oil in said pools without avoidable waste.

RULE 1 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

- A. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.
- B. The Board expressly reserves the right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
