INC. AND MEASON OPERATING COMPANY
FOR PERMISSION TO MULTIPLY COMPLETE
THE W. E. O'MALLEY, INC. GREEN-BURLEY
NO. 1 WELL LOCATED IN SECTION 15,
TOWNSHIP 5 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, ADAMS
COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

ORDER

This cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi on the Petition of W. E. O'Malley, Inc. and Meason Operating Company to define the Benbrook Sand Oil Pool and the Walker Sand Oil Pool, both of the Wilcox Formation, as found in the W. E. O'Malley, Inc. Green-Burley No. 1 Well located in Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and further requesting authority to multiply complete said well in said pools; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in accordance with the law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that the Board has jurisdiction of the subject matter and pursuant to said notice that public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building in Jackson, Mississippi, on July 15, 1981, at which time and place all persons who desired to be heard on said matter were heard, and the Board having fully considered the evidence and recommendations presented and being of the opinion that the relief sought by Petitioners should be granted;

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the relief sought by Petitioners be granted and that W. E. O'Malley, Inc. and Meason Operating Company be allowed to multiply complete and produce the W. E. O'Malley, Inc. Green-Burley No. 1 Well located in Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, in the Benbrook Sand Oil Pool and the Walker Sand Oil Pool as defined herein.

BENBROOK SAND OIL POOL: The Benbrook Sand Oil Pool is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 6,474 feet and 6,479 feet by electrical log measurement in the W. E. O'Malley, Inc. Green-Burley No. 1 Well located from the northeast corner of Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, go westerly along the north boundary of Section 15 for 1815 feet; thence southerly at right angles for 415 feet to well location in Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and all productive extensions thereof.

WALKER SAND OIL POOL: The Walker Sand Oil Pool of the Wilcox Formation is defined as that interval productive of hydrocarbons between 6,618 feet and 6,668 feet by electrical log measurement in the W. E. O'Malley, Inc. Green-Burley No. 1 Well located from the northeast corner of Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, go westerly along the north boundary of Section 15 for 1815 feet; thence southerly at right angles for 415 feet to well location in Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and all productive extensions thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the Petitioners are hereby

granted permission to multiply complete both the Walker Sand Oil Pool and the Benbrook Sand Oil Pool through a single string of tubing by drilling out the cast iron bridge plug which is set at 6,580 feet and putting said well back on production producing both the Walker Sand Oil Pool and the Benbrook Sand Oil Pool Zones simultaneously through one string of tubing.
