

IN RE: DOCKET NUMBER 117-49-19
ORDER NUMBER 262 -49

This day this cause came on for hearing on the application of Humble Oil & Refining Company for an order recognizing and establishing the North Baker Pool as a separate and distinct oil pool in the LaGrange Field, Adams County, Mississippi in addition to the four pools presently recognized under prior orders of this Board in said field and for the fixing of the maximum efficient rate of production of oil from the drilling units in said pool and the allocation of the production therefrom; and

It appearing that due, proper and legal notice of said meeting has been given in the manner and way provided by law and by the rules of this Board, and that due and proper proofs of publication of notice are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of said cause; and

The Board having heard the evidence of witnesses and the statements made to the Board and the arguments of counsel and the State Oil and Gas Board being of the opinion that the application of Humble Oil & Refining Company should be granted;

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board that the North Baker Pool in the LaGrange Field, Adams County, Mississippi be and the same is hereby recognized and established as an oil pool separate and distinct from the four pools heretofore recognized and established in said field by order of this Board No. 112-49, which said pool is hereby defined and identified as follows:

"The North Baker Pool, which was found productive in the Humble No. 1 Mrs. B. B. Moore, et al well located in the approximate center of Section 60, Township 7 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, from a depth of 6070 feet

to 6,087 feet, being that zone which is presently producing in Humble Nos. 1, 2 and 4 Mrs. B. B. Moore et al, Humble No. 1 E. V. Doiron et al, Cities Service No. 3 C. W. Hazlip and Kingwood Nos. 2 and 3 E. Stanton wells in the LaGrange Field, which said North Baker Pool has an oil-water contact of between sub sea 5846 and 5852 feet which is separated from the other producing areas in the field by a structural low area and a shale barrier both trending in an East-West direction and located in the north part of Section 83 and extending into Sections 77 and 78 all in Township 7 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi. That said pool, being a part of the LaGrange Field, shall be subject to the special field rules adopted by the Board applicable to said field.

It is further ordered and adjudged and said Board does hereby find and fix the maximum efficient rate of production of oil in the North Baker Pool of the LaGrange Field, Adams County, Mississippi at 100 barrels of oil per day per drilling unit and the Board further finds the allocation of oil in said pool shall be based upon the aforesaid maximum efficient rate of production and that the aforesaid maximum efficient rate of production is hereby fixed for a period of six months from December 1, 1949 for the protection of the correlative and co-equal rights of the owners in said field and for the purpose of preventing waste in said field.

IT IS FURTHER HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board that in the event new wells are brought in as commercial producers in said pool between the date of this order and the next regular meeting of the State Oil & Gas Board, the allowable for such well shall be set by the Supervisor subject to confirmation of the Board at its next regular

meeting but in no event shall said allowable exceed the allowable set for the pool as a whole nor shall such allowable exceed the maximum efficient rate of production set for said pool.
