ORDER AMENDING SPECIAL FIELD RULES
OF THE LA GRANGE OIL FIELD TO INCLUDE
THE 4600 FOOT WILCOX OIL POOL THEREIN,
AND SETTING THE MAXIMUM EFFICIENT RATE
OF PRODUCTION THEREFOR.

This day this cause coming on to be heard on the Petition of Sohio Petroleum Company, a corporation, for the purpose of amending the Special Field Rules of the La Grange Oil Field (Order No. 112-49 of this Board) to classify and identify the 4600 Foot Wilcox Oil Pool as a separate pool and making said special field rules applicable to said 4600 Foot Wilcox Oil Pool; and to set a Maximum Efficient Rate of production for said pool and to allocate and apportion such production among the wells completed therein; and confirming all wells heretofore drilled and completed in said pool, and it appearing unto this Board, and said Board does so find and adjudicate that due, proper and legal notice of this meeting and of the petition filed in this cause has been given in the manner and the form provided by law and by the rules and regulations of this Board, and that due and proper proof of all legal and required notices are on file with this Board in this cause, and that this Board has full jurisdiction of this cause, and that petitioner has filed a proper petition, and the Board has heard and considered the same, together with the oral and documentary evidence adduced at the hearing and argument of counsel, being fully informed and satisfied that the relief prayed for in said petition should be granted:

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the 4600 Foot Wilcox Oil Pool, which was found to be productive in the Sohio Petroleum Company, Parker-Baker Unit No. 3 Well located in Lot 175 of La Grange Field Area, Section 34, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, said sand occurring at a depth of 4592 to 4624 feet (sub-sea depth of 4255 to 4287 feet); that said pool is now producing in said Lot No. 175 and in the Texas & Pacific Oil Company O. L. Wilson No. 2 Well located in Section 8, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi; that said pool is a separate and distinct oil pool

completely disconnected from any of the other producing pools or reservoirs in said Field.

It is further ordered and adjudged that the Special Field Rules for the La Grange Field, being Order No. 112-49 of this Board, be and the same are hereby amended by adding to and incorporating within Rule I thereof the abovementioned definition of the 4600 Foot Wilcox Oil Pool and by extending the productive extensions defined within the Wilcox formation underlying the La Grange Oil Field as being between the approximate depth of 4590 and 6500 feet.

It is further ordered and adjudged that the aforesaid Special Field Rules of La Grange Field are hereby in all particulars made applicable to the 4600 Foot Wilcox Oil Pool, and all of the wells heretofore drilled and completed in said Pool and the drilling units on which same are located are hereby confirmed.

It is further ordered and adjudged that the Maximum Efficient Rate of production in said pool be and it is hereby fixed at 100 barrels of oil per drilling unit per day until further order of this Board.
