FINAL ORDER

This day this cause coming on to be heard on the Application of John B. Echols to define the Second Wilcox Oil Pool located in the Lake Lucille Field, Adams County, Mississippi, and this Board finding that due and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering the above Applicant has been given in the manner and form prescribed by the Rules and Regulations of said Board, and that due and proper Proofs of Publication of all legal and required notices are on file with the Board in this cause, and that said Board has full jurisdiction over the parties involved herein, and the right to hear said cause and determine the same at the regular August 15, 1984, meeting of said Board, and it further appearing to the Board that the above Application was presented as a contested matter before the Board on an emergency basis and the Board issued an Emergency Order at its regular July 18, 1984, meeting granting said Application, and based on testimony and evidenced presented at said July meeting, the Board finds as follows, to-wit:

(1)

That Applicant, together with others for whom he is authorized to act, are owners in the leasehold estate on which the Echols & LeBlanc-Breaux 11-7 Well is located, said

well being located 270 feet from the south line and 568 feet from the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW/4 of NE/4) of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 3 West, Adams County, Mississippi. That said well and the unit assigned thereto is in the Lake Lucille Field, Adams County, Mississippi.

(2)

That the Echols & LeBlanc-Breaux 11-7 Well was drilled on lands located in the Lake Lucille Field and was drilled pursuant to the applicable Rules and Regulations of the Mississippi State Oil and Gas Board. That said well is presently in commercial production and is being reported to the State Oil and Gas Board by its Operator as the F. & H. Production Services 11-7 Breaux Well. That Applicant desires to designate and define the Second Wilcox Oil Pool located in the Echols & LeBlanc-Breaux 11-7 Well in the Lake Lucille Field, as follows:

The Second Wilcox Oil Pool shall be designated and defined as those strata of the Second Wilcox Sand of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the measured depth of 4790 feet to 4824 feet in the Echols & LeBlanc-Breaux 11-7 Well, located 270 feet from the south line and 568 feet from the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW/4 of the NE/4) of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 3 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.

(3)

That the above described Second Wilcox Oil Pool is a separate and distinct reservoir which is not in communication with any other reservoir or producing formation, pool or horizon.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Second Wilcox Oil Pool of the Wilcox Formation as found in the lands hereinabove described lying within the limits of the Lake Lucille Field, Adams County, Mississippi, be, and the same hereby is, designated and defined as follows:

The Second Wilcox Oil Pool shall be designated and defined as those strata of the Second Wilcox Sand of the Wilcox Formation productive of oil from the measured depth of 4790 feet to 4824 feet in the Echols & LeBlanc-Breaux 11-7 Well, located 270 feet from the south line and 568 feet from the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SW/4 of the NE/4) of Section 11, Township 4 North, Range 3 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.
