THIS MATTER came on for hearing upon the petition of Getty Oil Company asking that Special Field Rules for Nettleton Field be adopted, and the Board, being fully advised, does find as follows:

1.

Proper, due and legal notice for the meeting of this Board to consider this application has been given as required by law and the rules of this Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication of notice are on file with this Board. The Board does further adjudicate that it has full and complete jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine this petition at this time and place.

2.

On August 27, 1980, the State Oil and Gas Board issued Permit No. 64 for the drilling of the Getty Oil Company - Schlicht 4-8 Well No. 1 in Monroe County, Mississippi.

3.

On January 21, 1981, the State Oil and Gas Board issued Permit No. 533 for the drilling of the Getty Oil Company - Stovall 3-11 Well No. 1 in Monroe County, Mississippi.

4.

Said wells have been successfully completed and Getty Oil Company filed its petition to establish Special Field Rules for the Nettleton Field. Said Field Rules should be defined as follows:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR
NETTLETON FIELD,
MONROE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Nettleton Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described land as underlain by the Evans Sand Gas Pool, the Lewis Sand Gas Pool, and all productive extensions thereof:

Monroe County, Mississippi

Sections 3, 4 and 5, Township
12 South, Range 6 East

Section 32, Township 11 South,
Range 6 East.

B. The Evans Sand Gas Pool of the Nettleton Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 2,170 feet and 2,200 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction Laterolog for the Getty Oil Company - Schlicht 4-8 Well No. 1, located 2,200 feet from the North line and 1,250 feet from the East line of Section 4, Township 12 South, Range 6 East, Monroe County, Mississippi, and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

C. The Lewis Sand Gas Pool of the Nettleton Field shall be considered those strata productive of gas and condensate in the interval between the depth of 2,434 feet and 2,457 feet as indicated on the Dual Induction Laterolog for the Getty Oil Company - Stovall 3-11 Well No. 1, located 1,500 feet from the South line and 1,600 feet from the West line of Section 3, Township 12 South, Range 6 East, Monroe County, Mississippi, and all correlative intervals in communication therewith.

Rule 1 - Applicability of Statewide Rules

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order 201-51, and all effective amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules, are hereby adopted and shall apply to this field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend, or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Special Field Rules for Nettleton Field, Monroe County, Mississippi, be adopted as hereinabove set forth.
