

IN THE STATE OIL AND GAS BOARD OF MISSISSIPPI

ORDER NO. 61-53

DOCKET NO. 54-53-58

This cause this day came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board for Special Rules in the Overton Field in Adams County, Mississippi; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to said matter has been given in the manner and way as provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proof of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS pursuant to said notice given a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk Building at Jackson, Mississippi on May 20, 1953, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matters were heard and all proposed special field rules were fully discussed and duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the opinion that the following special field rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the correlative rights of all owners in said field;

It is, therefore, hereby ordered by the State Oil and Gas Board that the following special field rules be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi for the Overton Field in Adams County, Mississippi, to take effect on and after May 20, 1953, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR OVERTON FIELD
IN ADAMS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Overton Field, as used herein, is that area in Sections 19, 20 and 21, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, and Section 12, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, Adams County, Mississippi, including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain by any of the Wilcox Pools hereinbelow described.

B. The Danciger Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from the depths of 6299 feet to 6307 feet in the Southern Production Company-Helis-~~Armstrong~~ ^{OVERTON} A-1 Well located in Section 12, Township 5 North, Range 3 West, 2540 feet North 83° 23' West from the Southwest corner of Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, in said county, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

The Lower McKittrick Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from depths of 6318 feet to 6331 feet in the Lee Oil & Exploration Company, et al-McCaleb No. 1 Well, located in Section 21, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, 3861 feet South 5° 1' East from the Northwest corner of Section 21, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

The Parker Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation which contain oil shows from a depth of 6420 feet to 6427 feet in the Lee Oil & Exploration Company, et al-McCaleb No. 1 Well, located in Section 21, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, 3861 feet South 5° 1' East from the Northwest corner of Section 21, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

The Ogden Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from a depth of 6448 feet to 6454 feet in the Southern Production Company-Helis-~~Sage~~ ^{OVERTON HILLS-SLIGO} Unit located 13-1 in Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, 700 feet South 12° West from the Southwest corner of Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be

correlated with this horizon.

The Upper Barksdale Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox formation productive of oil from a depth of 6511 feet to 6516 feet productive of oil in the Southern Production Company-^{OVERTON HILLS # A-1}~~Helis-Armstrong B-1~~ Well located in Section 19, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, 1552 feet South 74° 15' West from the Southwest corner of Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

The Lower Barksdale Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata in the Wilcox formation productive of oil from a depth of 6520 feet to 6536 feet in the Southern Production Company-^{OVERTON HILLS A-1}~~Helis-Armstrong B-1~~ Well located in Section 19, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, 1552 feet South 74° 15' West from the Southwest corner of Section 18, Township 5 North, Range 2 West, Adams County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated with this horizon.

RULE 1-

No well shall be drilled less than 100 feet from any other producing well, regardless of the Pool from which it is producing.

RULE 11-

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51 and amendments thereto not specifically covered in the foregoing rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said Field.

RULE 111-

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the above rules and regulations.

Said rules to be in full force and effect on and after May 20, 1953, reserving, however, unto all parties the full benefit and protection of any rights accruing to said parties which may have become vested by law in such parties, prior to the adoption of said rules.
