POOL CREEK FIELD

Jones County, Mississippi

This cause coming on for hearing at the regular October, 1961, meeting of the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi on the Petition of TEXACO Inc. to amend the Special Field Rules of the Pool Creek Field, Jones County, Mississippi; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice for the purpose of this petition has been given in the manner and time provided by law, proofs of publication thereof being on file with this Board; and

The Board further finding that it has full and complete jurisdiction to hear and finally determine this matter at this, the regular October, 1961, meeting of the Board, all persons of record in favor of the petition and all persons opposing the petition of record being present and having been heard; and

The Board having fully considered the petition, the evidence and recommendations made, both in favor of the petition and against the petition, now finds and adjudicates that the relief sought in the petition should be granted in order to prevent waste and to protect the correlative rights of all parties interested in said field.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board of Mississippi that the following amendments to the Special Field Rules of the Pool Creek Field, Jones County, Mississippi, be and the same are hereby adopted by the State Oil and Gas Board to take effect on and after the date hereof, to-wit:

The definition of the Pool Creek Field is hereby amended to read as follows:

"A. The Pool Creek Field, as used herein, is that area in Sections 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27, of Township 9 North, Range 10 West, Jones County, Mississippi, and including all productive extensions thereof, which area is underlain in whole or in part by the Pine Island Oil Pool, the Rodessa Oil Pool, the Sligo Oil Pool and the Hosston Oil Pool."

Immediately following the definition of the Sligo Oil Pool, the Special Field Rules are amended to include the following defined Hosston Oil Pool, to-wit:

"E. The Hosston Oil Pool as used herein shall be construed to mean those strata productive of oil and/or gas in the Hosston formation at the subsurface depth interval of 11,312 feet to 11,621 feet, as indicated by the electrical log in the Texaco Inc. Alfred Foote Well #1, located 480 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 9 North, Range 10 West, Jones County, Mississippi, or sands correlative to this strata found in other wells."

That in all other particulars, said Special Field Rules of the Pool Creek Field, Jones County, Mississippi, are to remain as heretofore adopted by this Board.
