O R D E R

THIS day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil & Gas Board on the Petition of C. A. Hurst for approval of special field rules for the Thorn Field, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board, and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on July 18, 1973, at which hearing all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and finds that Special Field Rules for Thorn Field should be adopted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the following Special Field Rules for the Thorn Field, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, be hereby adopted:

Special Field Rules for the Thorn Field, Chickasaw County, Mississippi:

A. The Thorn Field as used herein is that area consisting of Sections 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 26, 27 and 28, T 13 S, R 2 E, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, underlain by the Mississippian "Sanders" gas pool and all productive extensions thereof.

B. The Mississippian "Sanders" gas pool in the Thorn Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian formation productive of gas in the interval between 3,442 feet to 3,504 feet in the Pan Am No. 1 Henry Black Well located in the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section 22, T 13 S, R 2 E, Chickasaw County, Mississippi, as indicated on the electric log of said well and all intervals correlative of said strata productive of hydrocarbons.

C. The characteristics of the Mississippian "Sanders" gas pool in said field are such that wells located on 320-acre gas well units in conformance with Statewide Rule 8 will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable gas from said pool without waste.

D. All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendments thereto not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

E. The Board expressly reserves the right after notice and hearing to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
