ORDER NO. 413-86ORDER

THIS DAY this matter came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the Petition of Pruet Production Company to amend the Special Field Rules of Tombigbee Field, Monroe County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that due, proper, and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter was given in the manner and way provided by law and the rules and regulations of the Board; and that due, legal, and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board; and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice given and the continuances granted by this Board, public hearing was held in the fourteenth floor auditorium of the Walter Sillers State Office Building, 550 High Street, Jackson, Mississippi, commencing on October 15, 1986, at which hearing all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all testimony and evidence were duly considered by those present at said meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Board, having fully considered said matter and the evidence and the recommendations made at said hearing, finds as follows:

1. With its Travelers Insurance Co. 1-6 No. 1 Well, completed in January 1984, Petitioner discovered the Tombigbee Field and a productive interval of the Sanders Sand therein. Initial production tests in March 1984 indicated

said well to be completed in a gas pool. As the result thereof, by Order No. 185-84, Docket No. 128-84-611, this Board established Special Field Rules for the Tombigbee Field and, therein, defined the Sanders Sand Gas Pool and established 320 acre spacing therefor. To date the Travelers Insurance Co. 1-6 No. 1 Well is the only well completed in the Tombigbee Field.

2. Between December 1985 and July 1986, the characteristics of production from this well changed from that normally produced by a gas well to the characteristics of a well producing from an oil pool. As of July 28, 1986, the well was producing 24 bopd and 50 mcf of gas. It is now apparent that said well is currently producing in an oil pool and that the Sanders Sand, as encountered by this well, should be further developed on 80 acre spacing with parameters consistent with Statewide Rule 7.1.

3. The Board finds that 80 acre spacing for the Sanders Sand oil pool of this field will effectively and efficiently drain all productive hydrocarbons from this pool, will promote development, will prevent waste, and will adequately protect the co-equal and correlative rights of all parties with an interest in this pool by allowing them to recover their fair and equitable share of hydrocarbons therein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Special Field Rules of Tombigbee Field be and are hereby amended as follows:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES  
FOR THE TOMBIGBEE FIELD  
MONROE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. FIELD AREA:

The Tombigbee Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of the following described lands, to-wit:

Section 36, Township 14 South, Range 7 East; Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 7 East; Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 8 East and Sections 26, 27, 34, and 35, Township 14 South, Range 19 West, Monroe County, Mississippi.

B. POOL DEFINITIONS:

1.1 The Sanders Sand Oil Pool in the Tombigbee Field shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian Formation productive of oil and other hydrocarbons occurring between the measured depths of 3,350 feet and 3,435 feet on the Dresser Atlas dual induction electric log of the Pruet Production Co., Baria & Mason, Munoxo - Travelers Insurance Co. 1-6 Well No. 1, and all sands correlative to and in communication with those strata which are productive of oil and other hydrocarbons, said well being located 2,000 feet from the West line and 1,800 feet from the North line of Section 1, Township 15 South, Range 7 East, Monroe County, Mississippi.

C. RULES:

RULE 1 - SPACING OF WELLS

1.1 As to each well drilled to and productive from the Sanders Sand Oil Pool:

(a) The well shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of (1) 80 contiguous surface acres, or (2) two (2) contiguous governmental quarter-quarter sections whose total acreage is not less than 72 or more than 88 acres; provided, however, there shall not be more than one well on the same unit producing from the same pool.

(b) The oil drilling unit for the well must be completely encompassed by the perimeter of a rectangle 1,600 feet by 2,725 feet; provided, however, no unit shall be permitted which will create island acreage.

(c) The well shall be located at least 1,000 feet from every other drilling well or wells completed in or producing from the pool; and

(d) The well shall be located no closer than 500 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

RULE 2 - APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

2.1 All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and any amendment thereto, not specifically

covered by the foregoing Special Field Rules are hereby adopted and shall apply to the field.

2.2 These Special Field Rules shall be in effect for one (1) year and shall terminate after the October 1987 regular meeting of the Board unless made permanent or otherwise extended, after notice and hearing.

2.3 The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any or all of the foregoing Special Field Rules, or to grant exceptions to all or any part thereof.
