THIS DAY this matter came on to be heard on Amended Petition of Centurion Resources, Inc., for adoption of Special Field Rules for Tremont Field, Itawamba County, Mississippi, and to designate and define three gas pools therein, and the Board, having considered the matter, finds as follows:

1.

Proper Notice to all interested parties has been given and this matter is properly before this Board.

2.

Tremont Field is comprised of that area in Sections 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9, Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Itawamba County, Mississippi, which is underlain by the Carter Sand Gas Pool, the Evans Sand Gas Pool and the Lewis Land Gas Pool of the Mississippian System, including all productive extensions thereof, as said pools are defined in the proposed Special Field Rules.

3.

It is essential that Special Field Rules for Tremont Field be adopted, after notice and hearing, properly defining the producing pools and the area of the Field, and providing for rules and regulations which may be found necessary for the proper and orderly development of the field, the prevention of physical and economic waste and the protection of co-equal and correlative rights of all owners and parties in interest.

Tremont Field is located within an area comprised of regular governmental sections containing approximately 640 acres each; the presently known characteristics of the Carter Sand

Gas Pool, the Evans Sand Gas Pool and the Lewis Sand Gas Pool, which underlie Tremont Field, indicate that gas wells located on units formed in the matter described in the Proposed Special Field Rules attached hereto as Exhibit "A" will adequately drain and produce the hydrocarbons in the pools underlying such units efficiently and without avoidable waste.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that:

1. Special Field Rules should be adopted for the Tremont Field, Itawamba County, Mississippi, defining and designating the gas pools therein, defining drilling units for said pools in the Field, and adopting such other rules and regulations with respect thereto that the Board determines proper;

2. The proposed Special Field Rules for Tremont Field, Itawamba County, Mississippi, proposed by the Petitioner and attached hereto as Exhibit "A", are deemed to be necessary for the proper and orderly development of the Field, the prevention of physical and economic waste and the protection of the co-equal and correlative rights of all the owners and parties in interest, and are hereby adopted as the Special Field Rules for Tremont Field, Itawamba County, Mississippi.

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**SPECIAL FIELD RULES  
FOR TREMONT FIELD,  
ITAWAMBA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI**

Tremont Field, as used herein, is that area consisting of Sections 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9, Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Itawamba County, Mississippi, underlain by the following described pools, and including all productive extensions thereof:

A. **The Carter Sand Gas Pool**, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian System productive of gas from a depth of 516 feet to 536 feet in the Moon-Hines-Tigrett Operating Co., Inc.-J. H. Stone Unit No. 1 Well, as shown by the electric log thereof, located 330 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Itawamba County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of gas which can be correlated therewith.

B. **The Evans Sand Gas Pool**, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian System productive of gas from a depth of 1158 feet to 1226 feet in the Moon-Hines-Tigrett Operating Co., Inc.-J. H. Stone Unit No. 1 Well, as shown by the electric log thereof, located 330 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Itawamba County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of gas which can be correlated therewith.

C. **The Lewis Sand Gas Pool**, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Mississippian System productive of gas from a depth of 1346 feet to 1383 feet in the Moon-Hines-Tigrett Operating Co., Inc.-J. H. Stone Unit No. 1 Well, as shown by the electric log thereof, located 330 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 10 East, Itawamba County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of gas which can be correlated therewith.

D. The characteristics of the above-mentioned gas pools are such that one well drilled on a regularly formed drilling unit conforming to the requirement of the rules herein contained will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable gas from such drilling unit in such pool without

avoidable waste.

**RULE 1—SPACING OF WELLS:**

Every well drilled as a gas well to the Carter Sand Gas Pool, the Evans Sand Gas Pool or the Lewis Sand Gas Pool:

(a) Shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of (i) Three Hundred Twenty (320) contiguous surface acres or (ii) a governmental half section containing not less than 300 acres nor more than 340 acres. In any case, no other drilling or producing well from the same pool shall be located on any such unit.

(b) Any gas drilling unit formed under Section (a) above must be completely encompassed by the perimeter of a rectangle 3735 feet by 5380 feet; provided, however, that no unit shall be permitted that would create island acreage.

(c) The well shall be located not less than 1320 feet from every other drilling gas well or gas well completed in or producing from the same pool located in conformity with this Rule.

(d) The well shall be located not less than 660 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

**RULE 2—APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES:**

(a) All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51, and all amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing Special Field Rules, are hereby adopted and shall apply to said Field.

(b) The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing rules and regulations.
