ORDER

This day this cause came on for hearing before the State Oil and Gas Board on the matter of the adoption and promulgation by the Board of Special Field Rules for the Turkey Creek Field, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, such hearing being called for such purpose; and

The Board finding that due, proper and legal notice of the meeting of the Board for the purpose of considering and taking action with respect to such matter has been given in the manner and way provided by law and the Rules and Regulations of the Board and that due, legal and sufficient proofs of publication are on file with the Board and that the Board has full jurisdiction of the subject matter to hear and determine same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice given, a public hearing was held by said Board in the Second Floor Auditorium of the Woolfolk State Office Building, Jackson, Mississippi, on September 16, 1964, at which time and place all persons present who desired to be heard on said matter were heard and all proposed Special Field Rules were fully discussed; and

WHEREAS, the Board has fully considered said matter and the evidence and recommendations made in said hearing and is of the opinion that the following Special Field Rules should be adopted for the prevention of waste and the protection of the co-equal and correlative rights of all owners in said field;

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED by the State Oil and Gas Board that the following Special Field Rules be and the same are hereby adopted to take effect on and after the date hereof, to-wit:

SPECIAL FIELD RULES FOR TURKEY CREEK FIELD  
IN WILKINSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

A. The Turkey Creek Field, as used herein, is that area in Section Eighteen (18), Township <sup>Four (4)</sup> ~~One (1)~~ North, Range <sup>one (1)</sup> ~~Six (6)~~ East, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, underlain by the pool hereinafter defined and all productive extensions thereof.

B. The Baker Sand Pool, as used herein, shall be construed to mean those strata of the Wilcox Formation underlying said field productive of oil from a depth of 6637 feet to 6653 feet in the Jones-O'Brien, Inc., U. S. A. No. 18-6 Well, located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, T 4 N, R 1 W, Wilkinson County, Mississippi, and including those strata productive of oil which can be correlated therewith.

C. The characteristics of the said producing pool in the Turkey Creek Field are such that the spacing and location of wells upon drilling units containing 80 contiguous surface acres conforming to the rules herein contained will efficiently drain and produce the recoverable oil from such pool without avoidable waste.

RULE I: SPACING OF OIL WELLS

Every well drilled as an oil well:

- (a) Shall be located on a drilling unit consisting of at least eighty (80) contiguous surface acres, or governmental quarter quarter sections having a boundary line in common and containing not less than seventy-two (72) acres, upon which no other drilling or producible well is located producing from the same pool;
- (b) The distance between any two points farthest apart on the drilling unit upon which the well is located shall not exceed 3150 feet;

- (c) No portion of the drilling unit upon which the well is located shall be attributed in whole or in part to any other drilling or producible well in the same pool;
- (d) The well shall be located at least 660 feet from every other drilling or producible well located in conformity with this rule;
- (e) The well shall be located at least 330 feet from every exterior boundary of the drilling unit.

RULE II: APPLICABILITY OF STATEWIDE RULES

All rules and regulations contained in Statewide Order No. 201-51 Special Rules and Amendments thereto, not specifically covered in the foregoing are hereby adopted and shall apply to said field.

The Board expressly reserves the right, after notice and hearing, to alter or amend or repeal any and all of the foregoing regulations.
